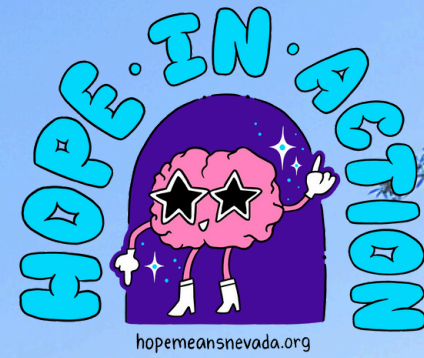

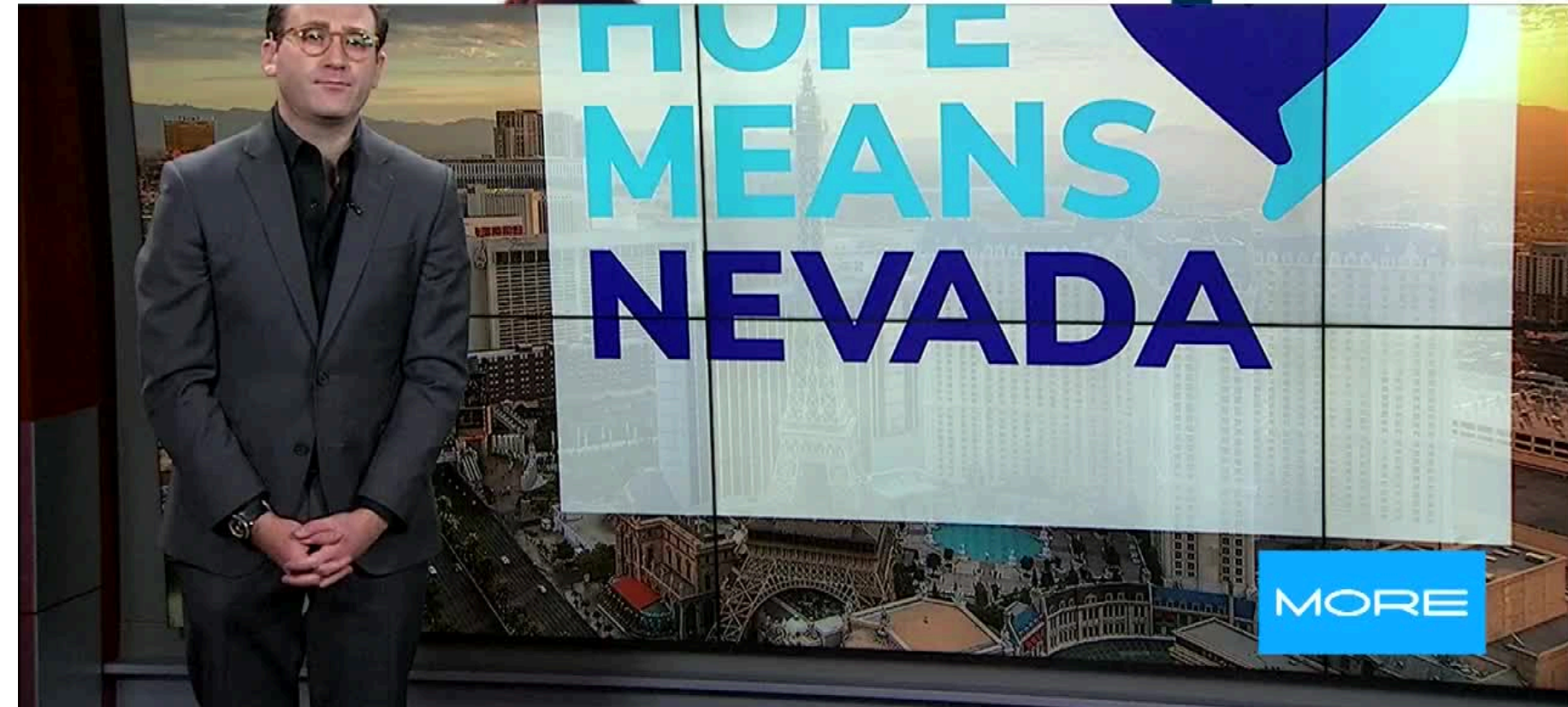

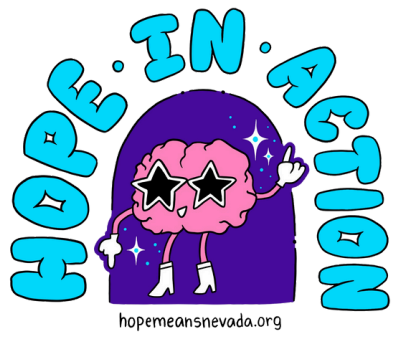

**Our mission is to eliminate teen suicide and  
empower Nevada youth to live hopeful lives.**

**In Nevada, suicide is the 1st  
leading cause of death for  
ages 12-19.**

**In Nevada, a young person  
dies by suicide every 5.29  
days.**

**In Nevada, for every teen  
who dies by suicide, it is estimated  
that 100-200 teens have attempted.**

**44% of teens in the US report  
feeling persistently sad and  
hopeless. This is up from 37% in  
2019 and the highest level ever  
recorded by the CDC.**
