


Hope in Action 2025 Action is the Antidote



In Nevada, for every teen who dies by suicide, it is estimated that 100-200 teens have attempted.

Our mission is to eliminate teen suicide and empower Nevada youth to live hopeful lives. In Nevada, suicide is the 1st leading cause of death for ages 12-19.

> In Nevada, a young person dies by suicide every 5.29 days.

44% of teens in the US report feeling persistently sad and hopeless. This is up from 37% in 2019 and the highest level ever recorded by the CDC.
